ABOUT THE GAMES

The World Police & Fire Games (WPFG) are an Olympic-style competition with thousands of athletes representing First Responders from different countries worldwide. This includes law enforcement, firefighters, and officers from corrections, probation, border protection, immigration, and customs. The Games are held biennially and typically have 60+ sports in the Official Games program.

The California Police Athletic Federation (CPAF), the Host City, and the WPFG Board of Directors govern the Games.

The Start of the Games

The first World Police & Fire Games were held in 1985 in San Jose, California. The World Police & Fire Games aim to offer the same variety of sports and the same high caliber of venues, officials, and athletic achievement as the original California Police Games but on a global scale. Since then, WPFG has been hosted several times in the United States and different countries, including Australia, Canada, China, Northern Ireland, Spain, and Sweden.

The size & scope of the World Police & Fire Games continue to grow. Attendance has steadily increased as have the number of countries involved. While attendance averages about 9,000, the 2011 WPFG in New York holds the current attendance record with over 16,000 athletes competing in 67 sports from almost 70 countries. More than 10,000 competitors competed in the Chengdu, China Games in 2019. With family & traveling companions, the number in overall attendance topped 25,000.

**WORLD POLICE & FIRE GAMES VOLUNTEER STORY:
Laurie's WPFG Life-Long Friends**

Laurie Curry spent more than 20 years as a physical education teacher, was a collegiate wrestler, and volunteered as a coach for countless sports and tournaments. Therefore, when the World Police & Fire Games began recruiting in Winnipeg Manitoba, her only question was, “where do I sign up?” According to Curry, this is what Winnipeggers do and from her perspective, following a worldwide pandemic, “our front-line workers deserve to be celebrated, to know how much we appreciate and need them.”

Curry selected the Toughest Competitor Alive contest because she felt it was most similar to what she enjoyed competing in as an athlete and felt she could relate. She was not disappointed, “I knew it would be packed with excitement,” she exclaimed. Looking back on her experience, she shares that volunteering for the World Police & Fire Games was a life-changing experience.

It was more than the amazing competitors from throughout the world or the competitions throughout her beloved city, it was the people she met. “Participating in these games impacted my life in many ways,” explains Curry, “I have life-long friends that I met and I am still in contact with...There is a group of Winnipeg ladies that I have had the privilege to get to know and this would have never happened without the games.” According to Curry, they meet for a meal once-a-month, to catch up, a bond that all began with their shared experience at the World Police & Fire Games.
