Veterans Park is open to public and accessible during the days leading up to the meet

Competition Schedule and Course Description

July 1st (Tuesday)

- Both 5K and 10K Race will start together at 8am
- One loop is a 5K
- This is a technical course. 400m grass straight away start then through the tunnel and onto a 10' wide trail. When it enters the wooded area, short hills and down hills with quick turns.

Sport Equipment

The course is such that you can wear Cross Country spikes or racing shoes. Where you cross cement drive ways the course will have material laid down.

Equipment Storage

Athlete sport bags can be checked in at athlete check in during the race. Please ensure your bag has a tag with your name and identification number.





Additional Sport Information

Bib pick up will be on site the morning of the race at athlete check-in. Athlete check-in opens at 6:30am
Race start time 8:00am

Water stations will be available for runners on the course.

The course path contains: Grass, dirt, gravel, hills, and hazards Example: Crossing Asphalt Path

Parking

There is free parking at Veterans Park and Spain Park High School

Regarding Teams: Teams are only available in the 10k event. It takes a minimum of (3) and maximum of (4) to create a Team. This event is available in 10-year age groups: 18+; 30+:40+: 50+: 60+: both genders set by the youngest runner of the team. If you are interested in joining a team or creating a team, go back online and ADD the event as the cost is \$16.00 per athlete. The team event has no effect on your individual entry.





Registration in Birmingham

All competitors are **REQUIRED** to register at the Birmingham–Jefferson Convention Complex Accreditation Center and receive their credentials no later than the day before their competition begins.

You must bring your department / agency identification when checking in at the accreditation center.
