Sport Equipment

WPFG will not provide any equipment. It is the responsibility of the wrestler to bring the proper dress and equipment needed for competition

- Equipment needed: 1 red singlet, 1 blue singlet, wrestling shoes

Equipment Storage

Changing rooms will be available at the venue to use. Any belongings are left at your own risk.





Additional Sport Information

Wrestlers will be required to stay in the stands unless in the hole or on deck for their match in which they will then be permitted on the floor in the warm up area. Only report to the competition mat when it is time for your match.

Wrestlers must have a medical release letter/physical signed by a licensed medical doctor within 6 months of competition.

If needed, there will be a training venue leading up to the days of the wrestling competition. Details are below:
